Clothing banks are initiatives set up to provide a valuable resource to service users needing clothing, footwear and/or toiletries.

The Clothing Bank Volunteer will support us with organising and processing all stock and identifying suitable and unsuitable donations.

## What you will be doing

- To check with your supervisor about priorities and any issues the volunteer should be briefed about.
- Help to sort the clothing that has been donated
- To identify suitable and unsuitable donations and arrange removal of unsuitable items
- Bundle clothing into types (e.g. men's tops, ladies trousers),
- To sort, hang or shelve the appropriate donated items in line with Health and Safety regulations.
- To keep the clothing bank tidy and organised
- Help publicise the clothing bank. This may involve speaking to staff, to check whether they need any clothing for their patients
- To undergo training as required
- To engage in monthly supervision/check in's with supervisor

- Able to use own judgement based on guidance
